

## **A CS-Powered Future**

Careers in computing are growing faster than any other employment category, with over 91% of available software positions located outside Silicon Valley<sup>1</sup>. In Illinois alone, 16,400 computing jobs open each month, despite fewer than 3,000 computer science graduates entering the statewide workforce each year<sup>2</sup>.

At the same time, only 54% of Illinois high schools currently offer computer science courses. Where CS courses are offered, students of color, women, and low income students participate at markedly lower rates<sup>2</sup>.

#### Building Prosperous CS Programs

The need for broader, more equitable access to CS education is clear - and **CS PD Week** is how Illinois' statewide K-12 community begins to close that gap.

During CS PD Week, new and experienced CS educators from around Illinois will:

- Engage with current CS curriculum
- Network and connect with peers
- Discover strategies for expanding access to highquality, inclusive computer science learning

Over the course of 5 days, participants will **learn about relevant topics** (including computational thinking, cybersecurity, and coding) from K-12 CS experts as well as **build community** during group meals and team-building activities.






#### ILLINOIS HIGH SCHOOLS OFFERING CS COURSES<sup>2</sup> 2021-22 SCHOOL YEAR
